The Steps

TO YOUR PERFECT WEDDING STATIONERY

1 THE BASE

Choose a cardstock that you love and that will blend well with your chosen wedding style, whether that be a colour, texture or shimmer, this will help in creating the perfect design.

O DESIGN

Whether you're after pastel hues or bright tones, consider if you want to use florals, minimal looks, emblems, sketches, or something different.

MAKE IT SHINE

Think about whether you want a simple print finish, or maybe you want to add sparkle, shiny backing, foil, glitter, or gold leaf finishing.

FINISHING TOUCHES

Is there anything you want to add? If it's an invitation maybe lined or printed envelopes, bands, wax seals, ribbons, charms, dried florals or

something more you.

STEP 1 Card stock

When choosing your base there are some things to consider. The first is style, for example if you're going for a rustic vibe, you'll want to avoid shimmers, pearls and metallics and maybe go for something more textured to give it a natural look.

Then consider the feel to touch. Whether it's textured or not, all card has a certain feel, so make sure you're happy with how it holds and whether it's thick enough for your desired look, also consider whether the texture is single or double sided.

Lastly, tone. Think about various tones of white, off white, ivory and so on. Certain textures will be different in hue, so even if it's white, compared with another texture it could look slightly brighter or darker. Textures will also change the look of a design and how the print sits on the surface.

The next few pages will go into detail on each card and how best to use it.



Top tipe

"Think about what your style is for the day and match the card to the look you're aiming for.

Also consider which ones are going to pull out your colours beautifully and which may fade them slightly or wash them out."

UNCOATED

The most commonly used, a smooth, subtly grained card that works with all invite types.

Weights: 150-350gsm Mid white tone - other shades available

Ideal for all styles, foiling, folding, single prints, double sided print, layering.



HAMMER

Off white tone with divot like pattern from soft raised bumps (single sided).

Weights: 150-300gsm Off white tone

Ideal for rustic, vintage, natural or romantic styles, good for use with folding and layering, not compatible with foiling.



DECKLED EDGE

This card is made from sustainable cotton and has a torn like effect on the edges.

Weights: 100-300gsm Natural cream tone

Ideal for romantic, vintage, classic or gothic weddings, great for folding, single prints and layering, not compatible with foiling.



KRAFT

Made from recycled card, a mid brown toned hue with speckles from its natural grain.

Weights: 200-300gsm Mid brown tone

Ideal for rustic, vintage, eco and natural styles, good for use with folding and layering, not compatible with bold colours.



PFARIFSCENT

A card with a shimmer to add class and luxury.

Weights: 100-300gsm Various colour options

Ideal for romantic, classy, royal, or fairytale weddings, great for folding, single prints and layering, not compatible with foiling or bold colours.



LINEN

A soft cotton like texture with small lines throughout.

Weights: 120-280gsm Various colour options

Ideal for classy or vintage styles, good for use with folding and layering, not compatible with foiling.



FI77 FMBOSSED

A unique look with a shallow embossed raised pattern (similar to hammer).

Weight: 280gsm Off white tone

Ideal for rustic, vintage, eco, or natural weddings, great for folding, single prints and layering, not compatible with foiling.



COLOURED

With a large range of pastel and bright colours, this is a versatile option.

Weights: 120-280gsm Various colour options

Ideal for all styles, great for pockets, folding and layering.



METALLIC

Adds shine to layers or backing to lift a design and add colour.

Weight: 280gsm Various colour options

Ideal for classy, fairytale or luxury weddings, great for backing, layering and bands, cannot be printed or foiled.



GLITTER

Adds sparkle layers or areas to designs, works great with pastel colour card.

Weights: 120-280gsm Various colour options

Ideal for classy, fairytale, luxury or classic weddings, great for backing, layering and bands, cannot be printed or foiled.



ROUGH UNCOATED

Similar to uncoated but with a deeper grain.

Weight: 300gsm White tone

Ideal for all styles, folding, single prints, double sided print, layering, not compatible with foiling.



FLECK

A more natural option featuring slight flecks of grain throughout the card.

Weight: 260gsm Ivory or white

Ideal for classy, eco or natural weddings, great for folding, layering, backing, not compatible with foiling.



VELLUM

A transluscent wax type paper with a modern look.

Weights: 100-300gsm Various colour options

Ideal for wraps, bands, envelopes or overlays onto backing card.



WHITE GRAIN

A little more out there with a speckled-like effect of natural grain.

Weight: 260gsm Off white tone

Ideal for rustic, boho, eco or natural weddings, great for folding, layering, backing, not ideal for foiling.



I FATHER GRAIN

More of a subtle texture but has a creased look throughout.

Weight: 250gsm Bright white

Ideal for folding, single prints and layering, not compatible with foiling.

STEP 2

Design phase

Once you have your base, we can get to work on choosing the right design to complete the look. Whilst this can be done in reverse order, I don't advise it for the reason that it can make things a little complicated, and the original design may not work on all cardstocks as well as you think.

When it comes to design I like to keep things fairly simple and it's advisable to always get your details together first, then design around the copy. This is because if there are any large florals etc, they can obstruct the path of the text and could end up being moved or changed when your details are added. Always make sure the item is serving its purpose first: to inform, direct or engage, then make it look beautiful.

If you're struggling on wording or how you'd like your stationery to look, I'll guide you through all of that in your consultation and create a brief to work from. Don't worry, I'll handle all the stress!



Top tipe

"Remember to make sure the item is serving its purpose. Keep text legible and clear, making sure all main details are included.
Also make sure that the design fits with your theme and style, so that on your wedding day it looks the part next to your gorgeous decor."

GET CREATIVE



MINIMAL

If you're after a minimal wedding, whether it be a rustic or classy occasion, keep it simple. Less is more with this look and space is definitely key, focus on larger calligraphy fonts and initial emblems to add visuals.



FLORAL

Either opt for dainty florals or large petals that fill the space, and add calligraphy fonts for some romance. Keep colours to a minimum and don't be scared to go big and bold.



PERSONAL

If you're looking for ways to add personality into your stationery, consider using photos, parts of your story or adding your hobbies and interests into the design.



FUN

If you really want to make a splash and add that wow factor, go for something unique, fun and totally you, maybe even something interactive to give your guests a brand new experience.


STEP 3 Time to shine

Depending on your style and theme you may decide to skip this step, which is absolutely okay! You may skip to step four.

However, if you are looking for ways to add some glamour, read on...

Adding sparkle whilst keeping things elegant can be tricky, but consider adding glitters, foil, gold leaf, maybe even metallic or glitter backing to elevate the design and add a luxurious wow factor.

If you're not yet sure on what to add to your dream design, check out the next page for some ideas on extra finishes to make your stationery stand out from the crowd.



Top tipe

"Less is more, so don't over sparkle a design and cover it head to toe in glitter. Give it space and add little areas of sparkle for a dainty yet elegant approach.

Secondly, try not to foil all text as addresses and important details can be difficult to read, stick to headers and names."

SHINE BRIGHT



BACKING

Whether glitter, metallic, or pearlescent, this will add a layer to your stationery giving it a fuller, more luxurious feel and will help add some sparkle for a touch of glam. Various colour options.



GOLD LEAF

Gold leaf is a more traditional way of adding some golden shine. It can be added in large or small areas but works best on edges to create a shiny border. Unlike glitter this won't shed once applied but is only available in gold.



FOIL

Foil is a more delicate choice and will add shine to any look. Remember to consider lighting for your on the day stationery, as foil needs a well lit area to shine. Various colour options. Minimum order requirement applies.



GLITTER

If you really want to sparkle, glitter is the one for you. Most often used with backing card or borders, but it works really well dotted around a design to add little touches of shimmer or on envelope liners. Various colour options.

STEP 4

Jinishing touch

And you've made it to the final step, yay!

Whether you need invitations, table plans or menus, all of these steps will help you create your desired look on your wedding day. But how do you make sure the look is complete?

Choosing how to finish your piece is important as it can make or break the design, it's all about balance and knowing when it's enough. Now of course if you're a minimal lover, you won't want to add much (if anything) other than maybe a coloured envelope. But if you're going for the wow factor there are little touches we can add to take the look from just enough to 'It's so beautiful, I'm in love!'.

If you're loving the design but it's just missing something, check out the next page for add ons and extras that will amaze your guests and make your creation truly you.



Top tipe

"Remember that sometimes it says enough, you may not need the final addition.

Theme your charms and embellishments to your day, i.e. a rose for a beauty and the beast wedding.

And lastly, let it be you."

IT'S THE LITTLE THINGS



ADD FUN

Add cute extras like hangers, bow ties or mini florals.

Ideal for fun and unique weddings.



ENVELOPES

Upgrade to coloured or vellum envelopes for extra class.

Ideal for classy, luxury or modern weddings.



STRING

Various colour options of twine, add tags or dried flowers.

Ideal for rustic, eco or natural weddings.



LINERS

Add a pattern or colour to the inside of your envelopes.

Ideal for classy, luxury or floral weddings.



WAX SEALS

Various colour & stamp options, personalised stamps also available.

Ideal for vintage, classy or modern weddings.



PRINTS

Printed envelopes are a great idea if you don't want to write out names and addresses, can be added to light or pastel colours.

RIBBONS



SATIN

Bold or pastel colours, soft smooth texture, holds in place.

Ideal for any wedding style.



ORGANZA

Thin sheer fabric, colours are more faded.

Ideal for classy, luxury or vintage weddings.



CHIFFON

Thinner softer material, frayed edges available.

Ideal for vintage or romantic weddings.



SILK

Heavier than satin, smooth in texture, frayed edges available.

Ideal for classy, luxury or modern weddings.



RIBBED

Lined effect thick ribbon, bold or pastel colours.

Ideal for unique, alternative weddings.



VELVET

Velvet fabric, thick and suede like feel, holds shape.

Ideal for classy, luxury or modern weddings.

TAGS

Various colour & material options.

Ideal for any wedding style.



CHARMS

Add small charms for a delicate touch.

Ideal for classy, luxury or modern weddings.



TASSELS

Various colour options, soft silk tassels.

Ideal for classy, romantic or boho weddings.



JEWELS

Add larger jewel embellishments or brooches.

Ideal for classy, luxury or traditional weddings.



BANDS

Personalise to your liking, various material options.

Ideal for any wedding style.



FLOWERS

Consider adding artificial or dried flowers.

WHAT IF I HAVE NO IDEA WHERE TO START?
